Ideas for Study Groups

1. The best size is 3-4 people.
2. Divide up the chapters covered on the exam.
 - Each member of the group should prepare a dialogue with blanks in it. The other members of the group can fill in the blanks.
 - Make each member an expert on a given chapter or chapters. The expert should go through the chapter and make a list of any colorful boxes. Report to group members the main/important topics of your chapter.
3. Find one exercise per chapter that we never did. Do it orally with your group.
4. Bring your quizzes and correct any errors together. Discuss *why* answers might have been incorrect.

Tips for Independent Study

1. Use the website exercises that come with our textbook <http://www.classzone.com/>. (Follow the prompts to find our book.)
2. Use the www.conjuguemos.com website to practice verb conjugation. Use your account, or, to avoid setting one up, just use the “demo version.”
3. Use the vocabulary lists at the end of each Unit (every 4 chapters) to make flash cards. Don't waste your time on words you know or words that are very close to English. Only do the difficult ones.
4. Find homework assignments with many mistakes. Copy them over, correcting your errors.
