

Homework Rubric: French 7-10

- ❖ Homework is graded on a scale of 10 or 20 points depending upon the length and/or difficulty of the assignment.
- ❖ All students will see the same number of correction marks (3-5 per assignment) but will earn different scores for the overall quality of their work.
- ❖ Moreover, students at different levels in this multi-level classroom are graded according to their class level.

10/10 or 20/20

- ✓ Done completely and according to the instructions.
- ✓ Clearly demonstrates the decision to challenge oneself (through, for example, choice of vocabulary, development of discourse or creativity).
- ✓ Few to no errors in basic verb conjugation, gender or agreement.
- ✓ Effort toward sophistication: Varied vocabulary, use of varied and advanced verb tenses, well-developed discourse.
- ✓ May have some errors in word choice, verb tense selection, preposition or article choice, idiomatic language or other more advanced or nuanced aspects of the language.

9/10 or 18/20

- ✓ Done completely and according to the instructions.
- ✓ Demonstrates, for the most part, the decision to challenge oneself.
- ✓ Limited errors in verb conjugation, gender or agreement.
- ✓ Compared to work at the 10/10 level, work at this level may demonstrate one of the following:
 - Be slightly less sophisticated in terms of varied vocabulary, use of advanced verb tenses and/or well-developed discourse.
 - Have a higher frequency of errors in word choice, verb tense selection, preposition or article choice, idiomatic language or other more advanced or nuanced aspects of the language.

8/10 or 16/20

Compared to work at the 9/10 level, work at this level may demonstrate **one** of the following:

- be almost but not quite completely done.
- not follow some of the instructions.
- have an increased frequency of errors in verb conjugation, gender or agreement.
- show little effort to challenge oneself.
- have marked errors in word choice, verb tense selection, preposition or article choice, idiomatic language or other more advanced or nuanced aspects of the language.
- lack sophistication as evidenced by limited or repetitive vocabulary, few verb tenses or brief, under-developed discourse.

7/10 or 14/20

Compared to work at the 8/10 level, work at this level may demonstrate **two** of the following:

- be almost but not quite completely done
- not follow some of the instructions.
- show little effort to challenge oneself.
- appear more error-full than error-free.
- lack sophistication as evidenced by limited or repetitive vocabulary, few verb tenses or brief, under-developed discourse.

6/10 or 12/20

- ✓ Incomplete and follows only some of the instructions.
- ✓ Errors begin to interfere with comprehension.
- ✓ Extremely repetitive and/or underdeveloped.

5/10 or 10/20, or, in extreme cases, lower

- ✓ More incomplete than complete.
- ✓ Does not follow instructions.
- ✓ Errors make comprehension difficult or nearly impossible.
- ✓ Extremely repetitive and/or underdeveloped.
