

Twelve Tips for Success in Spanish 3-4

1. Always come prepared for class with your binder (with paper), red pen, blue or black pen and both of your books.
2. Spend at least five minutes per day studying your flash cards or vocabulary lists for the current chapter.
3. Go through all of your vocabulary (present and past chapters) at least once a month.
4. **DO YOUR HOMEWORK!**
5. Keep track of your homework calendar. (You also should date your homework and keep it in chronological order in your binder.)
6. Correct the homework when we go over it in class with a red pen. That way you know where you are making mistakes.
7. If you make more than 2 or 3 mistakes on a homework assignment, come to see me as soon as possible. That way we can make sure that we can resolve your problem before the quiz or test.
8. If you get below a C on a quiz or test, Please come to tutoring and you can get special help.
9. Always make sure that you have corrected the answers that you get wrong on a test or quiz, so you can use the quiz/test as a study tool.
10. Make use of the Academic Resource Center.
11. Take every opportunity to speak Spanish in class – even if you aren't sure (it is all about taking risks.) **YOU CAN'T LEARN TO SPEAK SPANISH IF YOU DON'T SPEAK!**
12. Do your best and try to have fun!
